Hanau Alumni Reunion - July 28-31, 2005

Hey Hanau Panthers,

Panther Pride 2005 has been set for July 28 (Early Bird Registration) through July 31 at the Sheraton Colony Square Hotel in Atlanta, Georgia. The Sheraton is a lovely hotel which overlooks the City of Atlanta, is a short MARTA (Atlanta's metro/subway service) ride from Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport and is close to numerous shopping centers and MARTA stops. You will be responsible for making your own hotel reservations so please contact the Sheraton as soon as possible to get those reservations underway. You can contact the Sheraton by calling (404) 892-6000 or by going to the Hanau Web site (www.hanauhigh.web.com) and clicking on the Hotel Reservation link. If you call in your reservation, don't forget to mention the Hanau High Reunion to get your special rate.

Because a number of you have written and requested a 4 day/3 night stay the hotel has offered two different packages. The cost for hotel room is as follows:

Regular double or king	\$ 99.00 + tax = \$105.93 per night
Club Level Upgrade	\$129.00 + tax = \$138.03 per night
Guest Suite Upgrade	\$179.00 + tax = \$191.53 per night

Total for Thursday through Sunday stay = \$317.79 - Regular; \$414.09 - Club Level Upgrade; \$574.59 - Guest Suite Upgrade

Total for Friday through Sunday stay = \$211.86 - Regular; \$276.06 - Club Level Upgrade; \$383.06 - Guest Suite Upgrade

There are a number of eateries that can be accessed directly from the hotel, plus a full service restaurant and bar.

Saturday, July 30, there will be a semi-formal dinner and dance. The cost of \$55 per person will cover the cost of dinner, gratuities, bartender/cashier fee and DJ. There will be a \$25 non-refundable deposit required. A registration form and more information will be provided shortly.

We have been doing some serious number crunching and based on the Hotel's contract we will be required to put down a deposit of at least \$800 by mid-January. Although there is some money in the account from the Reunion 2000 there is not nearly enough to cover our initial deposit, which is why I'm writing to you. (This is the part of my job I really hate).

I was hoping that some, or all of you, who have hopes of attending the reunion would be willing to make a small donation of \$10 to \$15 dollars to put towards deposits and decorations. The Committee has happily agreed to donate what we can, but even our small amount won't go far when it comes to deposit time.

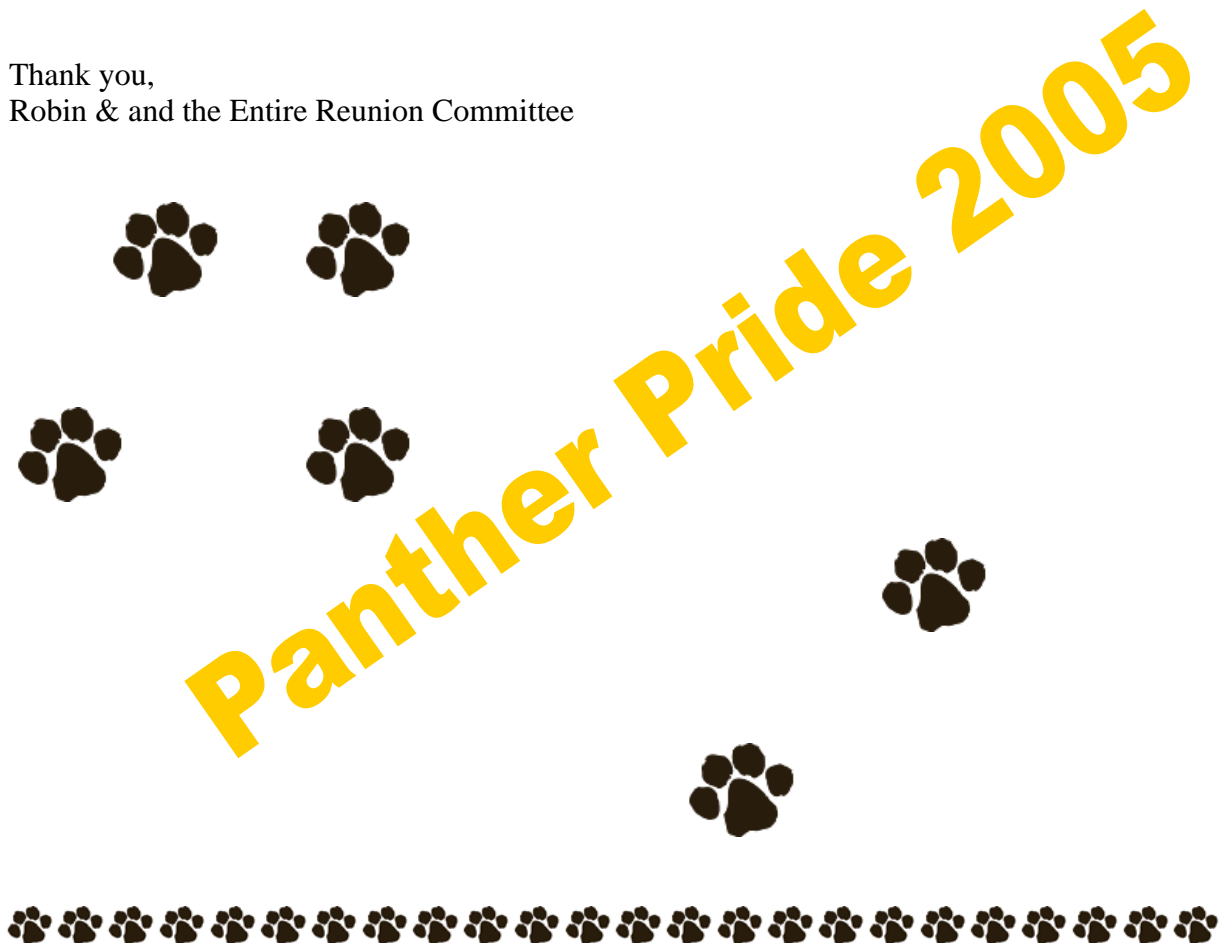

Time Management Tips for High School Students

It's 10:00 -- Do You Know Where Your Homework Is? Does it seem like there's never enough time in the day to get everything done? Feel like you're always running late? Here are some tips for taking control of your time and organizing your life.

1. Make a "To Do" List Every Day.

Put things that are most important at the top and do them first. If it's easier, use a planner to track all of your tasks. And don't forget to reward yourself for your accomplishments.

2. Use Spare Minutes Wisely.

Get some reading done on the bus ride home from school, for example, and you'll kill two birds with one stone.

3. It's Okay to Say "No."

If your boss asks you to work on a Thursday night and you have a final exam the next morning, realize that it's okay to say no. Keep your short- and long-term priorities in mind.

4. Find the Right Time.

You'll work more efficiently if you figure out when you do your best work. For example, if your brain handles math better in the afternoon, don't wait to do it until late at night.

5. Review Your Notes Every Day.

You'll reinforce what you've learned, so you need less time to study. You'll also be ready if your teacher calls on you or gives a pop quiz.

6. Get a Good Night's Sleep.

Running on empty makes the days seem longer and your tasks seem more difficult.

7. Communicate Your Schedule to Others.

If phone calls are proving to be a distraction, tell your friends that you take social calls from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. It may sound silly, but it helps.

8. Become a Taskmaster.

Figure out how much free time you have each week. Give yourself a time budget and plan your activities accordingly.

9. Don't Waste Time Agonizing.

Have you ever wasted an entire evening by worrying about something that you're supposed to be doing? Was it worth it? Instead of agonizing and procrastinating, just do it.

10. Keep Things in Perspective.

Setting goals that are unrealistic sets you up for failure. While it's good to set high goals be sure not to overdo it. Set goals that are difficult yet reachable.
